HIGHLIGHTS OF SIGNIFICANT ACHIEVEMENTS

➤ Excellent interviewing skills demonstrated by

- Providing compelling coverage of protests and news conferences in Louisville, KY, related to the Breonna Taylor case, a controversial national story concerning the police shooting of a young woman of color.
- Presenting a story with strong emotional appeal regarding the need for a refurbished basketball court for underprivileged youth, prompting a strong public response and an anonymous donation of \$25,000, which exceeded the goal for the cause by more than \$10,000.
- Using effective interpersonal skills to gain the confidence of interview subjects for inquiries into sensitive matters and by, at all times, maintaining the confidentiality of information sources.

➤ Resourceful journalist

- Obtained the only interview with attorney Benjamin Crump, legal representative of several victims in a civil lawsuit against former Oklahoma City police officer Daniel Holtzclaw, who abused his position to coerce sexual favors, in a case that generated widespread national interest.
- Gained admission to witness the botched execution of an Oklahoma death row inmate, and appeared on the CNN program Out Front, with Erin Burnett, to provide a graphic and meticulously detailed accounting and timeline of this disturbing event.
- Developed a historical long-form piece covering the desegregation of South Carolina schools during 1963, consisting of five separate segments and absorbing interviews with former Black pupils who participated in this struggle.
- Conveyed warmth and empathy to foster a comforting environment that persuaded the parents of a child struck and dragged by a car to grant exclusive interview.
- Developed a reputation for unbiased, ethical reporting, free of any allegations of inappropriate, inaccurate, or plagiarized content.

- Served as the spokesperson for numerous public health campaigns sponsored by, among others, the American Heart Association, the Oklahoma Blood Institute, and the Muscular Dystrophy Association.
